Applications will be evaluated for style and expression as well as content by a committee consisting of the Superintendent, High School Principal, High School Counselor, High School English Teacher, Senior Sponsor and High School Band Director. \$300.00 each will be issued based upon net income earned from the corpus of the Trust. The scholarships will be payable directly to the accredited college/university after the students provide proof of enrollment.
